As per the directions from the Joint Director of College Education, Vellore, the College reopened for the Academic Year 2024-2025 on Monday, 19 June 2024. The Students Induction Program for the 1st years was conducted from 1st July 2024 to 5th July 2024. It (SIP) was inaugurated by our College Secretary & Correspondent, Mr. Nazar Mohamed. The regular classes commenced from 11th July 2024 as the bridge course was conducted from 06th July to 10th July 2024.

The admission for UG & PG courses for the academic year 2024-2025 began on 15th May 2024 and closed on 31st August 2024 for UG Courses and on 13.10 2024 for PG Courses.

IQAC Activities:

Organized Programs

- **IQAC & Students Meeting on 24.06.2024**

A meeting with IQAC and II & III year students regarding academic performance was held on June 24, 2024, at NMZ Auditorium. The IQAC Director, M.A. Uzefa Rashida, welcomed the gathering. - **Orientation Program on Software Development Training (13.08.2024)**

The IQAC, in collaboration with AspiraSys, organized an Orientation Program on Software Development Training for students on August 13, 2024, at N.M. Zackariah Auditorium. Mr. N. The primary objective of the workshop was to equip students with the necessary skills, strategies, and knowledge to navigate the challenges of the job market and to enhance their employability. The workshop focused on preparing students for the modern job market, including resume-building, leveraging social media platforms like LinkedIn, and gaining insights into internship opportunities in the IT sector. Total 213 Final Year Students benefited.

- **Five-Day Hybrid Mode Faculty Development Program**

The IQAC organized a Five-Day Hybrid Mode Faculty Development Program on Transforming Higher Education: Institutional Autonomy and NEP 2020 Implementation from 10th to 15th May 2025. The program was inaugurated by Dr. T.
