ADMISSION POLICY & PROCESS

Date: 03.05.2023

The Admission Process is undertaken by the Admission Committee which follows the norms of the Admission Policy of the State Government of Tamil Nadu as given below.

- The Prospectus and the Fee structure for various courses are displayed in the College Website.
- 2. The Applications are received online.
- 3. The following Registers and other related documents pertaining to the students admission are maintained:
- List of Applicants received within the last date of admission fixed by the Thiruvalluvar University.
- Applications with copies of related credentials and Original TC from the institution last studied.
- vi. Nominal Roll list is prepared based on the admissions.
- 4. The Admissions are made purely on merit comes Conduct basis subject to the reservation policy of the Government of Tamil Nadu as stated below:
 - i. 31% of Open Competition
 - ii. 26.5% for Backward Classes (BC) other than BC Muslims and 3.5 % for Backward Classes Muslims.
 - iii. 20% for Most Backward Classes (MBC) and Denotified Communities (DNC).
 - iv. 15% for Scheduled Classes (SC) and 3 % for SCA
 - v. 1 % for Scheduled Tribes (ST).

5. The rule of reservation will apply to:

50 % of seats in the case of Aided Minority Colleges.

- 6. If the number of Applications from Minority Communities is less than 50% of total seats, the remaining Minority Quota is filled up in accordance to the rule of reservation.
- 6. Admission Committee is responsible for the entire admission process in the college.
